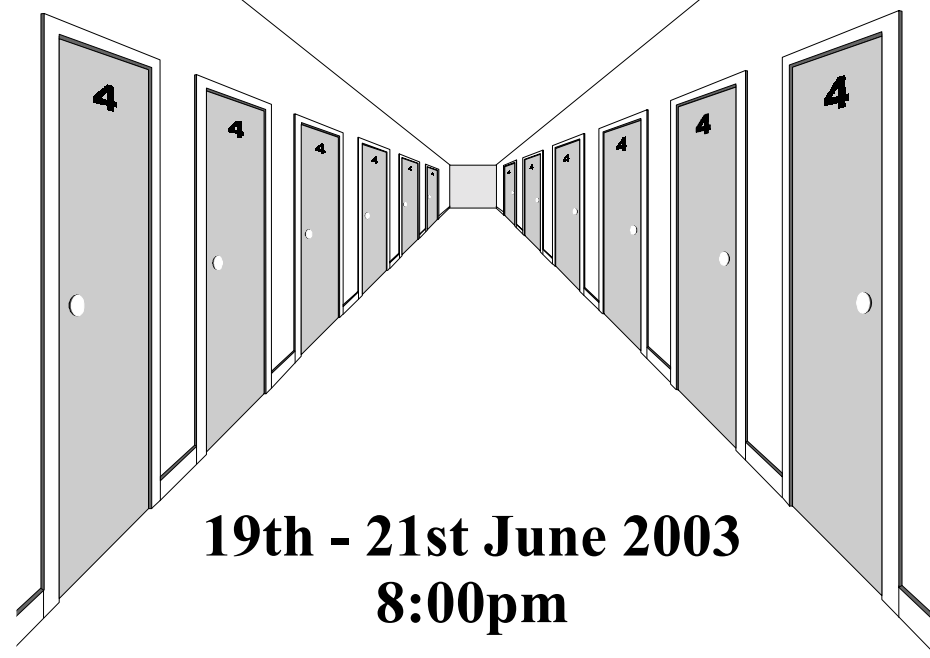

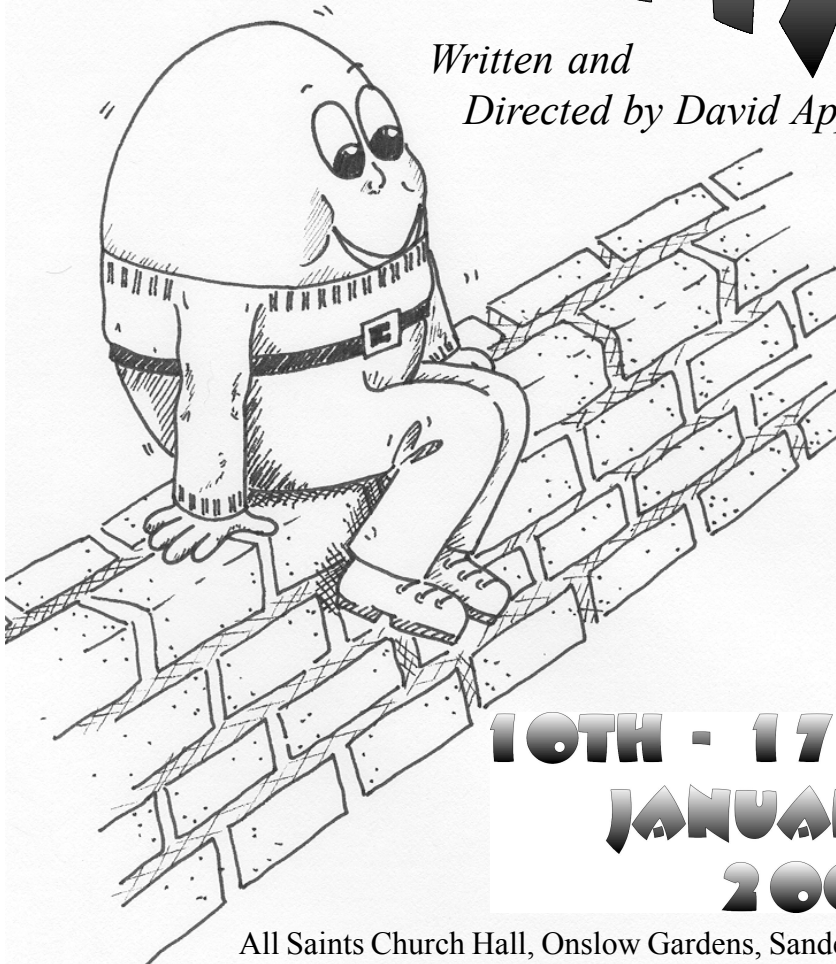

May I welcome you to our Summer Production of "Confusions", our first at St. Antony's Church Hall.
